- d. COORDINATE THE MASTER PLANNING EFFORT WITH THE LAKE COUNTY DIVISION OF TRANSPORTATION

**SUMMARY OF PUBLIC MEETING INPUT #2
JANUARY 21, 2008 AT LINDENHURST PARK DISTRICT LIBRARY**

MAJOR PEDESTRIAN / BIKE PATHS THAT WOULD LIKE TO BE DEVELOPED

1. ENGLE MEMORIAL PARK (COMMUNITY CENTER) THROUGHT THE HASTING PROPERTY TO THE LAKE VILLA DISTRICT LIBRARY
2. HERITAGE TRAILS PARK/MILLBURN WEST SCHOOL THRU OAK RIDGE PARK & WETZEL FIELDS GOING SOUTH THRU LAKE COUNTY FOREST PRESERVE, McDONALD WOODS/FOREST VIEW PARK TO TO THE SOUTH TO CONNECT VILLAGE GREEN AND ONTO ROLLINS SAVANNA
3. ENGLE MEMORIAL PARK TO LAKE COUNTY FOREST PRESERVE HASTINGS LAKE PROPERTY TO GELDEN ROAD,. WEST TO POLLEY FIELDS/LAKES COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL; TO GO WEST ACROSS DEEP LAKE ROAD, TO LAKE VILLA (FIELD OF DREAMS, ETC.)

AREAS OF CONCERN

1. DEEP LAKE ROAD HAS TIGHT BERMS TO THE ROAD, SWALES, AND SPEEDING CARS
2. FROM ENGLE MEMORIAL PARK (COMMUNITY CENTER), TO THE STOP LIGHT OF GRASS LAKE/BECK ROAD, CROSS TO SOUTH SIDE ARRIVE SAFELY AT HASTINGS LAKE, THE ONLY PEDESTRIAN CROSSING EAST / WEST IS ON GRASS LAKE ROAD. LOOK FOR OTHER OPTIONS TO HAVE A SAFER CROSSING.
3. INCLUDE THE CURRENT SIDEWALK CONNECTION FROM THE MCDONALDS WOODS TO LEWIS PARK.
4. WHAT TRAILS WOULD BE ADA ACCESSIBLE?
5. WHERE SHOULD SIGNAGE BE ON ROADWAYS FOR PARKS AND TRAILS CONNECTIONS?
6. ARE THERE ANY OTHER ALTERNATIVE PATH CONNECTS THAN USING MAIN ROADS?
7. WHAT IS THE BEST OPTION TO CONNECT FROM LAKE COUNTY FOREST PRESERVE'S DUCK FARM DOG EXERCISE AREA OFF GRAND AVEUNE TO THE LAKE VILLA DISTRICT LIBRARY

3. LAKE COUNTY FOREST PRESERVE'S ROLLINS SAVANNA TO THE SOUTH
