

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Lindenhurst Park District is committed to conducting its recreation programs and activities in a safe manner and holds the safety of participants in high regard. The Lindenhurst Park District continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions that are designed to protect the participants' safety. However, participants and parents/guardians of minors registering for this program must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities.

You are solely responsible for determining if you or your minor child/ward are physically fit and/or adequately skilled for the activities contemplated by this agreement. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way, or recently suffered an illness, injury, or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity.

WARNING OF RISK

Soccer is a sport, which challenges and engages the physical, mental, and emotional resources of each participant. However, despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning, and equipment, there is still risk of serious injury (including exposure to a communicable disease). Understandably, not all hazards and dangers can be foreseen. Because soccer is a contact sport played with little or no equipment and because it puts great demands on stamina, the very nature of the game of soccer is hazardous and risky. Such risks and dangers include, but are not limited to, the acts of kicking, heading and fielding the ball, colliding with other players or stationary objects, being struck by errant balls, running, jumping, stretching, sliding, diving, acts of God, inclement weather, poor officiating, equipment failure, failure in supervision, rocks or holes in playing fields, incorrect footwear in poor weather conditions, and all other circumstances inherent to the sport of soccer. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Lindenhurst Park District to guarantee absolute safety.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in signing up and participating in this program/activity, you will be expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and waiving and releasing all claims for injuries, damages, or loss which you or your minor child/ward might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with this program/activity (including transportation services, when provided).

I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to participants in this program, and I voluntarily agree to assume the full risk of any injuries (including exposure to a communicable disease), damages, or loss, regardless of severity that my minor child/ward or I may sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with or associated with this program/activity. I further agree to waive and relinquish all claims I or my minor child/ward may have (or accrue to me or my minor child/ward) as a result of participating in this program/activity against the Lindenhurst Park District, including its officials, agents, volunteers, and employees (hereinafter collectively referred as "Parties").

I do hereby fully release and forever discharge the Parties from any and all claims for injuries (including exposure to a communicable disease), damages, or loss that my minor child/ward or I have or which may accrue to me or my minor child/ward and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with this program/activity.
