About Us

Lindenhurst Park District is located in northwestern Lake County, Illinois. The District was formed in April, 1988, making us one of the youngest Park Districts in this area. However, it's one of the fastest growing Park Districts with a variety of recreational programs and parks to offer. We currently have 19 named park sites which includes 2 beaches (25 parcels of open space total), that offer some of the newest active features around, combined with designated passive/natural areas. We also have a Community Center with a full size gymnasium, 3 lane suspended walking/jogging track, fitness equipment, dance studio, senior/adult room, preschool and multi-purpose rooms, conference room, and they are all ADA accessible.

Thomas J. Lippert Community Center Expansion!



IN MEMORIAM

Dear Friends and Neighbors:

It is with deep regret that we announce the passing of our former Park Board President Dean Parkman on April 26, 2022.

Dean moved to Lindenhurst with his family in 1981 when he was assigned to U.S. Army Recruiting Command at Fort Sheridan. He retired from the Army in 1988 after serving 20 years as an infantry officer. After completion of law school in 1991, Dean started his second career as an attorney with the Department of Veteran Affairs from 1992 to 2007.

Dean became a Park Commissioner in 1991 and served as the President of the Lindenhurst Park District for over 30 years. At that time the Lindenhurst Park District had an office at the Village Hall. Since his service began on the board, the Lindenhurst Park District has completed many major projects including Phase I and II of the Community Center, acquisition and development of Millennium Park, acquisition and development of Oak Ridge Park, and a new playground in front of the Community Center. Dean served on IAPD's Board of Commissioners as a trustee and was also a member of the Joint Legislative and Joint Distinguished Park and Recreation Accreditation Committees.

He was a member of St. Raphael the Archangel Church, Lake Villa VFW Post #4308, and coached for the Lindenhurst Soccer Program for many years. Dean enjoyed gardening, traveling, and especially spending time with his family.

We are forever grateful for his invaluable contribution to the Lindenhurst Park District and the Parks and Recreation field. He will be missed by all who had the pleasure and privilege to know him.

Are You R (resident) or NR (non-resident)?

Resident rates apply to those persons residing within the boundaries who contribute financial support to the Park District through property taxes. Those residents outside the Lindenhurst Park District boundaries are termed non-residents-but are always welcome. The easiest way to check this is look at your county tax bill (check for Park District taxes paid). The Park District will ask for proof of residence.



How to Create a New Client Account

If you do not have an account, go to our website at www.lindenhurstparks.org.

1. Click on the **Programs tab**, then click on **Register Now!**
2. Go to the **My Account tab** in the upper right hand corner, and click **Create an Account**. Complete the fields. The account must belong to an adult 18 years or older.
3. You will receive an email confirmation your account was successfully created. This email must be validated to activate your account information.

Log-in to an Existing Account

There are several ways you can access your account once it has been activated. Go to our website at www.lindenhurstparks.org.

You Can Either:

- Under the **Contact Us tab**, select **My Account**.
- or Select the **Programs tab**, Click-on **Register Now on Amilia!** then click on **My Account**.

-You can also choose an activity to register for and you will be prompted to log-in.

-Remember your email address is your user-name. If you forget your password you can reset it once you log-in with your user-name, or choose to log-in via Facebook, Google or Office 365.

How Do I Pay?

Payments may be made by cash, check or charge (we accept Visa, MasterCard, or Discover). Checks should be made payable to the Lindenhurst Park District. There will be an automatic \$25.00 service charge on all returned checks and credit cards with insufficient funds.

Refund Policy

Program refund requests (less a \$5 service charge for programs under \$99 or a \$10 service charge for programs over \$100) must be received at least seven 7 days before the start of a program. After that, refunds can only be given for medical reasons or relocation and will be pro-rated. When the district cancels programs due to low registration, full refunds will be given. Refund checks will be mailed within 14 days of the request. If registrations were paid by credit card, the charge account will be credited. Please note that refunds cannot be given for programs or trips that require advance admission or tickets, unless the district cancels them.

Program Hours

The Before & After School Program provides care for children from 6:30am until 5:30pm.

Location

Children enjoy activities in our Thomas J. Lippert Community Center, located at 2200 E. Grass Lake Road in Lindenhurst where they have access to a gymnasium, track, playground, and classroom space for activities.

Early Release/No School Day Care

We will observe school holidays, institute days, and early release days in accordance with Lake Villa District 41. Days-Off Care will include supervised play or special activities.

Late Registration

Late registration will be permitted if space allows; a \$40 late fee will be charged per child.

Refund Policy

A refund request must be given 7 days before the start of the program to receive a refund (less a \$5 or \$10 service charge).

What to Bring!

- Face masks are optional. Subject to change based on current applicable local and state guidelines.
- A nut-free snack and pre-filled water bottle each day.

REGISTRATION HIGHLIGHTS

- Daily Fees
 - AM Care (6:30am-bus pick-up) \$10 per day
 - PM Care (bus drop off-5:30pm) \$16 per day
- A per year \$50 non-refundable registration fee per child is required to participate.
- A mandatory credit card authorization form must be completed and a credit card on file with the Park District is required to participate in the program.
- Register by month – you have the flexibility to choose your days and times – this can change month to month. Each registration is due 7 days before the new month begins.
- Registration and payment are required prior to each monthly session and can be done in-person or online.
- Flexibility to register for days off school as needed.
- Parents are responsible for contacting the school and bus service to make bussing arrangements.

Parkman Pavilion Rentals


The Parkman Pavilion in Engle Memorial Park is a beautiful outdoor venue for ceremonies, parties or performances.



Park Use Regulations

Conduct Code ORD. NO. 00-02-01

The Lindenhurst Park District's Regulations apply to all public parks in Lindenhurst. The following regulations are important for park-users safety and park preservation.

1. Park hours are sunrise until sunset.
2. Pets are not allowed on park property.
3. "Smoke Free Environment" in all parks and facilities.
4. Permits are required by groups of fifteen(15) individuals or more.
5. Parents are responsible for the supervision and conduct of their children at all times. Please use your discretion as to your child's physical ability to use any of the playground equipment.
6. No placement of signs, decorations and structures without prior written Park District approval.
7. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on park property.
8. Unless grill is provided, open fires and grills are prohibited.
9. No golfing is allowed on park property.
10. For everyone's safety, fishing from beaches is prohibited while there is swimming activity.
11. Trash must be disposed of in the provided receptacles. It is unlawful to litter, deface, damage or destroy park property.
12. Tent, volleyball, canopy or any type of stakes are not permitted on the grounds without approval.
13. Loitering in parking lots is not allowed.
14. Please notify the Park District immediately of any hazardous or unsafe conditions.
