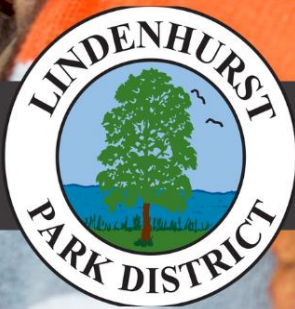

Lindenhurst Park District has a five (5) member Board. The Board members are unpaid and elected to six (6) year-term positions. Park Board members must reside within the Park District boundaries. Primarily, the Park Board establishes policies based on sound research and consideration of community needs. They adopt policies that allow the Park District to run efficiently, effectively, legally, and ethically. They request, receive, evaluate, and make decisions based on guidance from the Executive Director. Lindenhurst Park District encourages public interaction and believes in being actively involved in our community.

### Board Meetings

Regular meetings of the Park Board of Commissioners are held on the second Tuesday of each month at 6:00pm at the Lindenhurst Park District. The public is always invited to attend. ### About Us

Lindenhurst Park District is located in northwestern Lake County, Illinois. The District was formed in April 1988, making us one of the youngest Park Districts in this area. However, it's one of the fastest-growing Park Districts with various recreational programs and parks. We currently have 19 named park sites, including two beaches (25 parcels of open space total), that offer some of the newest active features combined with designated passive/natural areas. We also have a Community Center with a full-size gymnasium, a three-lane suspended walking/jogging track, fitness equipment, a dance studio, a senior/adult room, preschool and multi-purpose rooms, and a conference room, and they are all ADA accessible. A new 5,800-square-foot expansion is scheduled to open in August of 2023. The expansion will include a dance/aerobic studio, multi-purpose room, storage, offices, and dedicated preschool space.

### Are You R (resident) or NR (non-resident)?

Resident rates apply to people residing within the Lindenhurst Park District boundaries who contribute financial support to the Park District through property taxes. Non-residents live outside the Lindenhurst Park District boundaries and are always welcome. The easiest way to check your residency is to look at your county tax bill (check for Park District taxes paid). The Park District will ask for proof of residence to establish your discount.

### How to Create a New Client Account

If you do not have an account, go to our website at [www.lindenhurstparks.org](http://www.lindenhurstparks.org).

1. Click on the **Programs tab**, then click on **Register Now!**
2. Choose an activity to register for and click **"Create an account"** on the bottom left of the pop-up window. The account must belong to an adult 18 years or older.
3. You will receive an email confirmation that your account was successfully created. This email must be validated to activate your account information.

### Log-in to an Existing Account

-You can also choose an activity to register for, and you will be prompted to log-in.

-Remember that your email address is your user-name. If you forget your password, you can reset it once you log-in with your user-name or choose to log in via Facebook, Google, or Office 365.

### How Do I Pay?

Register online using Visa, MasterCard, or Discover. For in-person, mail-in, or Dropbox, cash, check, or charge payments may be made. Checks should be made payable to the Lindenhurst Park District. There will be an automatic \$25.00 service charge on all returned checks and credit cards with insufficient funds.

### Refund Policy

To receive a refund, you must withdraw from a program at least 7 days prior to the start. Program refunds will be less a \$5 service charge for programs under \$99 or a \$10 service charge for programs over \$100. Withdrawals within one week of the start date will only be refunded for medical reasons or relocation and will be pro-rated. Full refunds will be given when the district cancels programs due to low registration. Refunds will be processed within 14 days of request. Please note all refunds will be processed as a household credit. Trips and special event refunds will be less prepaid costs such as tickets, admission, and meals.

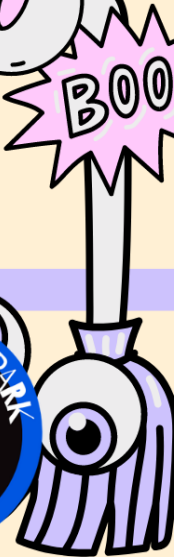

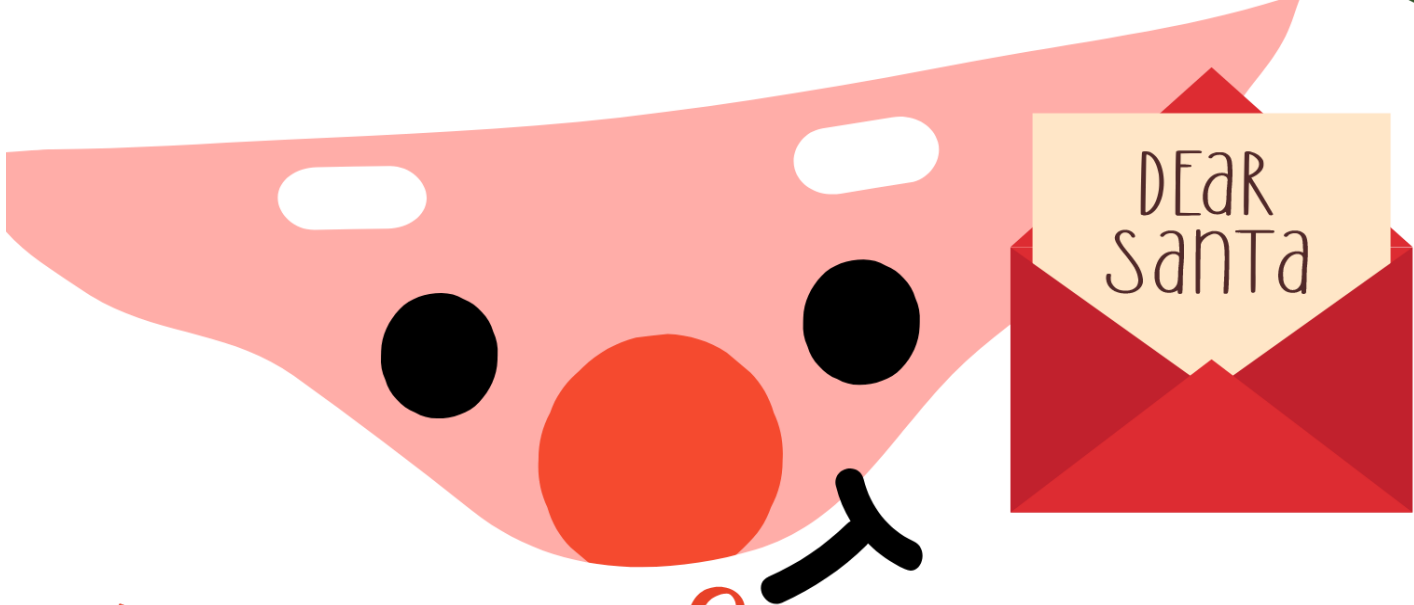

## HOW TO REGISTER

To register for the Before & After School Program, please visit [www.lindenhurstparks.org](http://www.lindenhurstparks.org) and follow these tabs:

- Programs>Register Now>Before & After School Program-2023/2024.
- Select the registration option that fits your family best for AM/PM Care and add it to your cart.
- You will then be prompted to pay in full for the days that you selected (drop-in), pay for the full month(monthly), or pay for your first installment (annual).

## Annual Registration **NEW!**

Register your child for AM and/or PM care for the full school year (excluding Days Off Care/School Breaks). You will be assigned an automatic installment plan during the online registration process. Installments will be the total annual fee broken into 10 equal payments. The first payment will be taken at the time of registration. Subsequent payments will be charged on the first of the month beginning August 1, and the last payment will be on April 1.

## Monthly (Session) Registration **NEW!**

Monthly Registration allows you to register for all program days during the month; choose AM and/or PM care. You will be prompted to pay in full for that month or call to set up an installment plan breaking your monthly fee into two payments; the first payment is taken at the time of registration, and the second payment is on the 15 of the month.

## Drop-In Registration

If you choose to register using the drop-in option you have the flexibility to choose individual days throughout the month in both AM and/or PM care. Drop-In registration must be completed on a monthly basis unless you register and pay in full for the entire school year. Installment plans are not available for drop-in registration.

## Registration Deadline

The registration deadline is 7 days prior to the beginning of the new month. Registration submitted after the 7 day deadline will incur a \$40 late fee if space is still available.

## Early Release/No School

The Before & After School Program will observe school holidays, institute days, and early release days in accordance with Lake Villa District 41.

## Transportation

Parents are responsible for contacting the school and bus service to arrange transportation. School Districts require students to have one drop-off and pick-up location throughout the year. If your child is not attending our program daily, consider using our location as their everyday pick-up/drop-off location.

## Refund Policy

Refunds for non-attendance, a partial month's attendance, or withdrawal mid-month will not be given. Families who have registered for the Annual option should call to stop monthly installments prior to the first of the month. Those registering month-to-month may stop registration at any time throughout the school year.

## What to Bring

Bring a nut-free snack and water bottle each day.

## FEES

- A registration fee of \$50 per child is required at the time of registration. This fee is non-refundable.
- **AM Care:**  
\$13 per day (drop-in) or \$12 per day (annual/monthly).
- **PM Care:**  
\$19 per day (drop-in) or \$18 per day (annual/monthly).
- A Credit Card Authorization Form must be completed and on file AND/OR a credit card must be saved to your household account with the Park District to participate in the program.
- Annual tuition installments are based on the total number of school days divided into equal payments (not the number of school days in the month).

Installment billing is available as an option during registration to those utilizing Annual or Monthly registration.

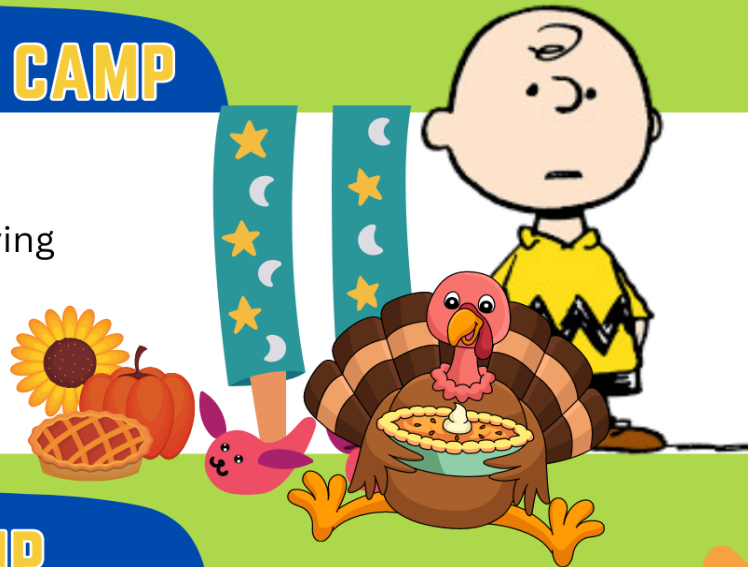

# ENGLE JUNCTION Preschool



## A Fun Place to Learn & Play!

The Lindenhurst Park District's Engle Junction Preschool provides a program for children ages three through four years of age. We strive to provide a warm, accepting environment where learning is fun. Our experienced teachers offer a variety of developmentally appropriate activities designed to help children learn and grow socially, emotionally, physically, and intellectually.

### Class Descriptions

#### 2.5-Year-Old Program NEW!

This NEW introductory program for young children focuses on early learning, creativity, and play, emphasizing getting along well with others in a group setting. This can be their first experience being responsible for themselves and adjusting to schedules and procedures. Pull-Ups are allowed.

#### 3-Year-Old Preschool

This class is great for children developing their early literacy, motor, and social skills. Students engage in creative projects, songs, and cooperative play every day.

#### 3-4-Year-Old Multi-Age Preschool

This hybrid class focuses on peer learning that mimics family and neighborhood structures. Older children feel pride when helping younger students, and younger students can push themselves and reach beyond their and their families expectations.

#### 4-Year-Old Preschool

This class is great for children developing their early literacy, motor, and social skills. Students engage in creative projects, songs, and cooperative play every day, emphasizing kindergarten readiness.

#### 4-Year-Old Pre-K Preschool

This 4 day/week class provides students with engaging, meaningful, and creative activities. With one more day of attendance, children have more experience and time to develop their skills for kindergarten.

### Our Philosophy

Engle Junction Preschool aims to provide a safe and nurturing learning environment where each child is recognized and appreciated.

## All-Aboard!

### Our Curriculum

Our curriculum, guided by the Illinois Early Learning Standards, is founded on the belief that children learn best through creative play and exploration. ### Payment Details

- A \$50 non-refundable registration fee will be charged at the time of registration.
- A deposit equal to one months tuition (used for May 2024) must be paid at the time of registration to secure your space for the upcoming year.
- If you choose monthly installments, eight equal payments will be automatically charged to your credit card on the first day of each month beginning in September and ending on April 1. A \$40 late fee will be applied if a payment is returned for insufficient funds.
- Tuition payments are based on the total number of school days divided into equal payments (not the number of school days in the month).

We often incorporate special activities to enhance the learning experience of our preschoolers. These activities may include visits from special guests, guest readers, field trips, themed days, and holiday parties.



### Refund Policy

**Refunds for a partial month's attendance or withdrawal mid-month will not be given.** The last month's tuition payment (paid at the time of registration) is non-refundable after August 15. If you withdraw before August 15, a full refund (less a \$10 service charge) will be issued. ## Parks

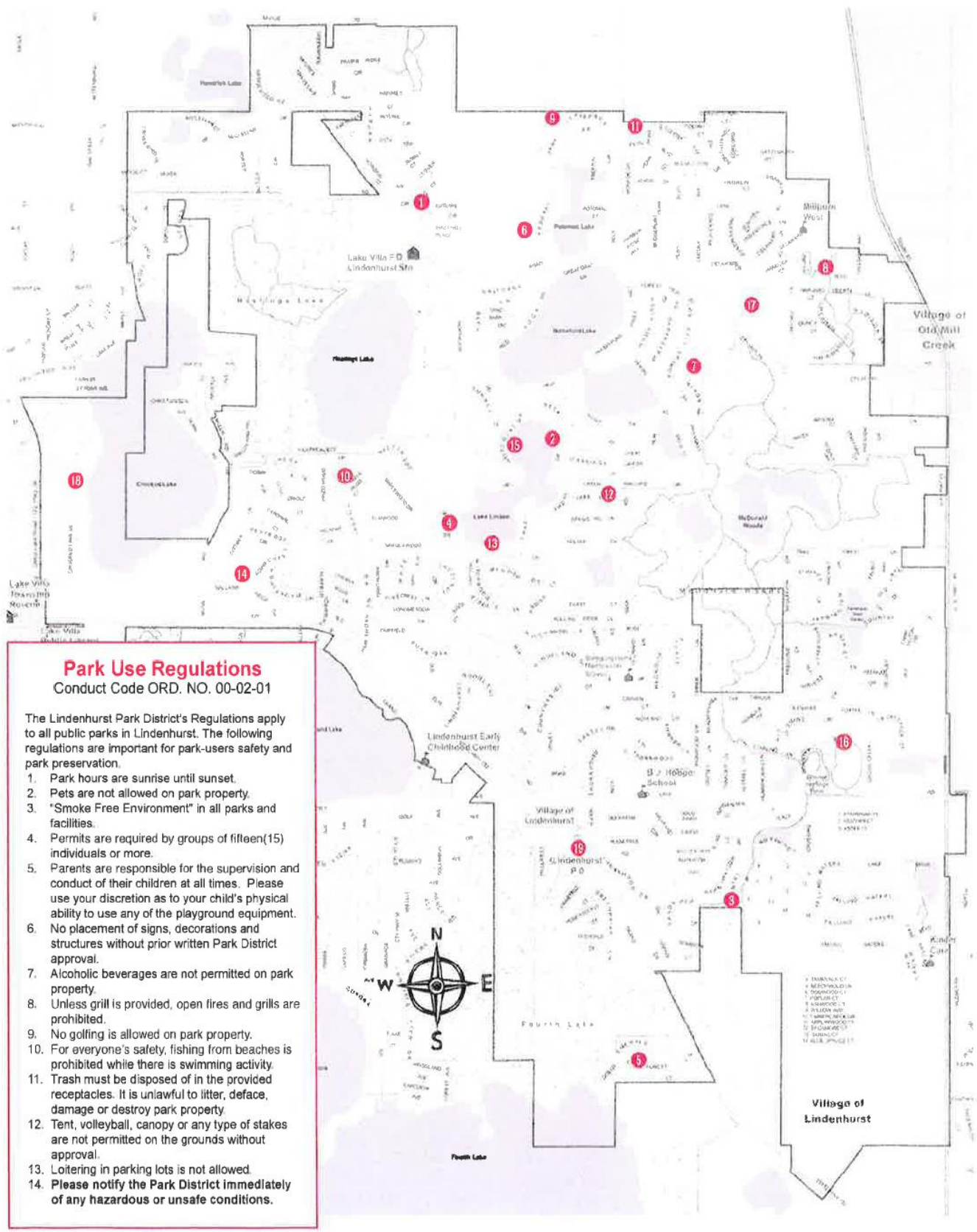

## Park Use Regulations

Conduct Code ORD. NO. 00-02-01

The Lindenhurst Park District's Regulations apply to all public parks in Lindenhurst. The following regulations are important for park-users safety and park preservation.

1. Park hours are sunrise until sunset.
2. Pets are not allowed on park property.
3. "Smoke Free Environment" in all parks and facilities.
4. Permits are required by groups of fifteen(15) individuals or more.
5. Parents are responsible for the supervision and conduct of their children at all times. Please use your discretion as to your child's physical ability to use any of the playground equipment.
6. No placement of signs, decorations and structures without prior written Park District approval.
7. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on park property.
8. Unless grill is provided, open fires and grills are prohibited.
9. No golfing is allowed on park property.
10. For everyone's safety, fishing from beaches is prohibited while there is swimming activity.
11. Trash must be disposed of in the provided receptacles. It is unlawful to litter, deface, damage or destroy park property.
12. Tent, volleyball, canopy or any type of stakes are not permitted on the grounds without approval.
13. Loitering in parking lots is not allowed.
14. Please notify the Park District immediately of any hazardous or unsafe conditions.
