Lindenhurst Park District has a five (5) member Board. The Board members are unpaid and elected to six (6) year-term positions. Park Board members must reside within the Park District boundaries. Primarily, the Park Board establishes policies based on sound research and consideration of community needs. They adopt policies that allow the Park District to run efficiently, effectively, legally, and ethically. They request, receive, evaluate, and make decisions based on guidance from the Executive Director. Lindenhurst Park District encourages public interaction and believes in being actively involved in our community.

Board Meetings

Regular meetings of the Park Board of Commissioners are held on the second Tuesday of each month at 6:00pm at the Lindenhurst Park District. The public is always invited to attend. About Us

Lindenhurst Park District is located in northwestern Lake County, Illinois. The District was formed on April 15, 1988. A five-member, non-paid elected board establishes policy for the district and provides direction on program and facility development. Our current park board has over 60 years of combined experience. We have a supporting cast of local individuals, organizations, government, and businesses, allowing our Park District to move forward progressively and accomplish improvements beneficial to you. Recreational opportunities continue growing with 19 named park sites, two beaches, 15 playgrounds, and 25 parcels of open space, totaling 134.5 acres, which offer great active features combined with designated passive/natural areas. We operate a 31,000 sq. ft. Community Center with a full-size gymnasium, 3-lane suspended walking/jogging track, aerobic and dance studios, senior/active adult room, preschool, multi-purpose and activity rooms, offices, and more, all ADA accessible. We have also made improvements at each named park and beach site within the decade, under a tax cap and without a referendum.

As we eagerly anticipate the arrival of summer with its promise of sunny days and refreshing evenings, the Lindenhurst Park District is overjoyed to share some fantastic news that will make the upcoming season even more special. The arrival of summer brings with it the thrill of the Community Partners Live Music in the Parks! This significant financial boost is earmarked for the extensive renovation of Lewis Park, a community favorite. The OSLAD grant symbolizes a major step forward in our ongoing efforts to enhance the recreational landscape and green spaces within Lindenhurst. With plans for playground enhancements, multi-use sports facilities, improved landscaping, ADA-compliant features, and community gathering spaces, the renovation of Lewis Park is poised to transform it into a more vibrant, accessible, and enjoyable space for everyone in our community. This initiative not only underscores our commitment to fostering a healthy, active, and connected community but also enhances the natural beauty and communal spirit of Lindenhurst. We extend our heartfelt thanks to the Illinois Department of Natural Resources for their support and to everyone in our community for their continued enthusiasm and engagement. Planning and demolition will take place in 2024. Construction will begin in April 2025 with a completion goal of August 2025.

Together, we are making Lindenhurst an even better place to live, play, and grow. Get ready for a summer filled with fun, excitement, and the joy of seeing Lewis Park flourish like never before!

How Do I Pay?

Register online using Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover. For in-person, mail-in, or Dropbox, cash, check, or charge payments may be made. Checks should be made payable to the Lindenhurst Park District. There will be an automatic \$25.00 service charge on all returned checks and credit cards with insufficient funds.

Refund Policy

To receive a refund, you must withdraw from a program at least 7 days prior to the start. Program refunds will be less a \$5 service charge for programs under \$99 or a \$10 service charge for programs over \$100. Withdrawals within one week of the start date will only be refunded for medical reasons or relocation and will be pro-rated. Full refunds will be given when the district cancels programs due to low registration. Refunds will be processed within 14 days of request. Please note all refunds will be processed as a household credit. Trips and special event refunds will be less prepaid costs such as tickets, admission, and meals.



WISH LISTS!

Wish Lists allow you to bookmark your favorite activities before registration begins and pick up where you left off when you are ready. This is a great way to save activities you may be unsure of registering for or save them ahead of time so you can find and register as soon as registration opens!

Are You R (resident) or NR (non-resident)?

Resident rates apply to people residing within the Lindenhurst Park District boundaries who contribute financial support to the Park District through property taxes. Non-residents live outside the Lindenhurst Park District boundaries and are always welcome. The easiest way to check your residency is to look at your county tax bill (check for Park District taxes paid). The Park District will ask for proof of residence to establish your discount.

Are you a **NEW** Lindenhurst Park District resident? Park District residents receive a 20% discount off most listed prices! Set up your resident discount by calling the office before registering online at 847.356.6011.

How to Create a New Client Account

If you do not have an account, go to our website at www.lindenhurstparks.org.

1. Click on the **Registration Tab** then click on **Register Now!**
2. Choose an activity to register for and click **"Create an account"** on the bottom left of the pop-up window. The account must belong to an adult 18 years or older.
3. You will receive an email confirmation that your account was successfully created. This email must be validated to activate your account information.

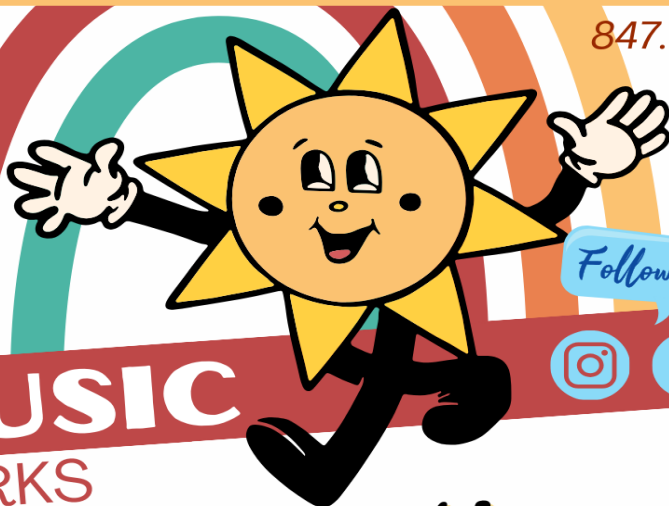

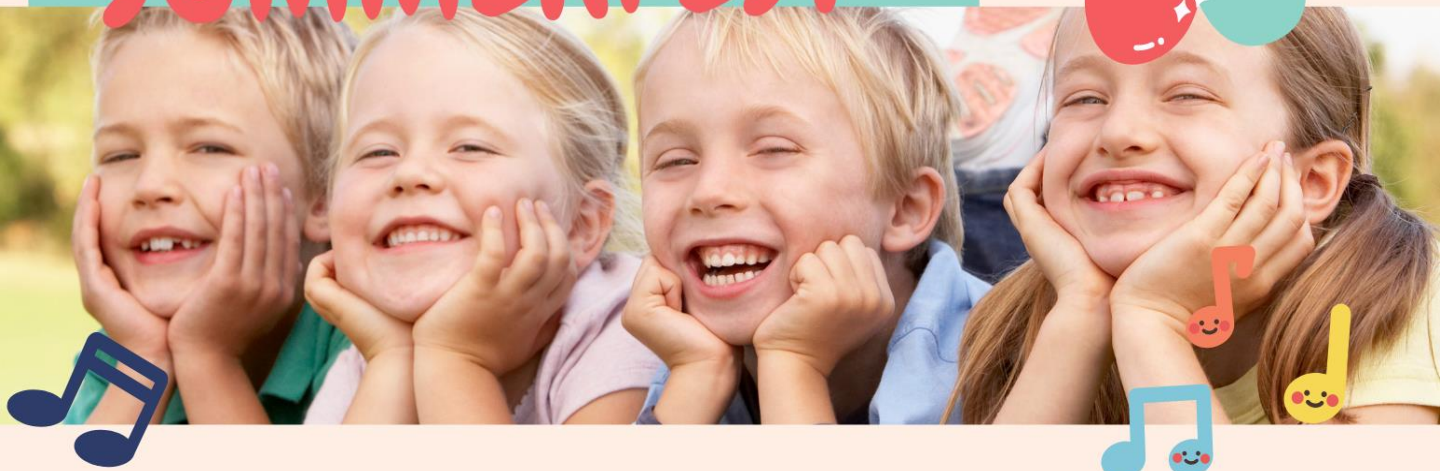

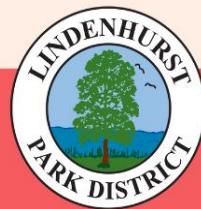

To register for the Before & After School Program, please visit www.lindenhurstparks.org and follow these tabs:

- Select the registration option that fits your family best for AM/PM Care and add it to your cart.
- You will then be prompted to pay in full for the individual days you selected (drop-in) or pay for the full month (monthly).

Transportation

Parents are responsible for contacting the school and bus service to arrange transportation. School Districts require students to have one drop-off and pick-up location throughout the year. If your child is not attending our program daily, consider using our location as their everyday pick-up/drop-off location.

Refund Policy

Refunds for non-attendance, a partial month's attendance, or withdrawal mid-month will not be given. Those registering month-to-month may stop registration at any time throughout the school year.

What to Bring

Bring a nut-free snack and water bottle each day.

Monthly (Session) Registration

Monthly Registration allows you to register for all program days during the month; choose AM and/or PM care. You will be prompted to pay in full for that month or call to set up an installment plan breaking your monthly fee into two payments; the first payment is taken at the time of registration, and the second payment is on the 15 of the month.

Daily (Drop-In) Registration

If you choose to register using the drop-in option you have the flexibility to choose individual days throughout the month in both AM and/or PM care. Daily registration must be completed before the monthly deadline on a monthly basis unless you register and pay in full for the entire school year. Installment plans are not available for daily registration. Pre-registration is required.

Registration Deadlines

The registration deadline is 7 days prior to the beginning of the new month. Registration submitted after the 7-day deadline will incur a \$40 automatic late fee if space is still available.

Early Release/No School

The Before & After School Program will observe school holidays, institute days, and early release days in accordance with Lake Villa District 41.

FEES

- A registration fee of \$50 per child is required at the time of registration. This fee is non-refundable.
- **AM Care:**
\$13 per day (daily) or \$12 per day (monthly).
- **PM Care:**
\$19 per day (daily) or \$18 per day (monthly).
- A Credit Card Authorization Form must be completed and on file AND/OR a credit card must be saved to your household account with the Park District to participate in the program.

Payment Plans

Installment billing is available as an option during registration to those utilizing Monthly registration. If you need a different plan, call our office at 847.356.6011.

A Fun Place to Learn & Play!

The Lindenhurst Park District's Engle Junction Preschool provides a program for children ages two and a half through four years of age. We strive to provide a warm, accepting environment where learning is fun. Our experienced teachers offer a variety of developmentally appropriate activities designed to help children learn and grow socially, emotionally, physically, and intellectually.

Class Descriptions

2.5-Year-Old Early Learner Program

This is an introductory experience for young children with a focus on early learning, creativity, and play, with the main emphasis on getting along well with others in a classroom setting. This can be their first experience being responsible for themselves and adjusting to schedules and procedures. Pull-ups are allowed.

3-Year-Old Preschool

This is a great program for children developing their early literacy, motor, and social skills. Students engage in creative projects, songs, and cooperative play every day.

3-4-Year-Old Multi-Age Preschool

This hybrid program has an extra focus on peer learning that mimics family and neighborhood structures. Children who are older feel pride when helping younger students and can push themselves and reach beyond their and their families' expectations.

4-Year-Old Preschool

This program is for children developing their early literacy, motor, and social skills. Students engage in creative projects, songs, and cooperative play every day with an emphasis on kindergarten readiness.

4-Year-Old Pre-K Preschool

This time-enhanced program provides students with engaging, meaningful, and creative activities daily. With one additional day of attendance, children have more opportunities and time to develop their skills for kindergarten.

Our Approach

Our curriculum, guided by the Illinois Early Learning Standards, is centered on the belief that children learn best through creative play and exploration. Our classrooms and curriculum have been carefully designed to promote varied learning experiences. Children participate in individual, small group, and whole-group activities daily.

We strive to prepare our students for kindergarten by incorporating activities that promote the development of social, emotional, physical, cognitive, and language skills.

Our teachers recognize each child's unique learning styles, needs, and interests and work diligently to offer learning experiences that are developmentally appropriate considering our students' ages, individual needs, and social and cultural contexts.

- Select “Preschool 24-25” at the bottom of the page.
- Choose the appropriate age and class selection.
- You will be prompted to pay in full or select monthly installments for the school year.

A \$50 non-refundable registration fee and a one-month tuition deposit (used for your last month’s tuition) will be charged at the time of registration.

If you choose monthly installments, eight equal payments will be automatically charged to a credit or debit card on the first day of each month beginning in September (the last payment will be withdrawn on April 1). A \$40 late fee applies if a payment is returned for insufficient funds.

Tuition payments are based on the total number of school days divided into nine equal payments (not the number of days in the month).

Requirements

- All children must be able to use the restroom independently unless enrolled in the 2.5-year-old Early Learner program.
- When enrolling in Engle Junction Preschool, your child must be the appropriate age by September 1.

Refund Policy

Refunds will not be given for a partial month’s attendance or withdrawal. The last month’s tuition payment, (paid at the time of registration), is non-refundable if a refund request is made after August 15. If a refund request is made before August 15, a full refund is granted (less a \$10 service charge). If you would like to withdraw, contact our front office at 847.356.6011.

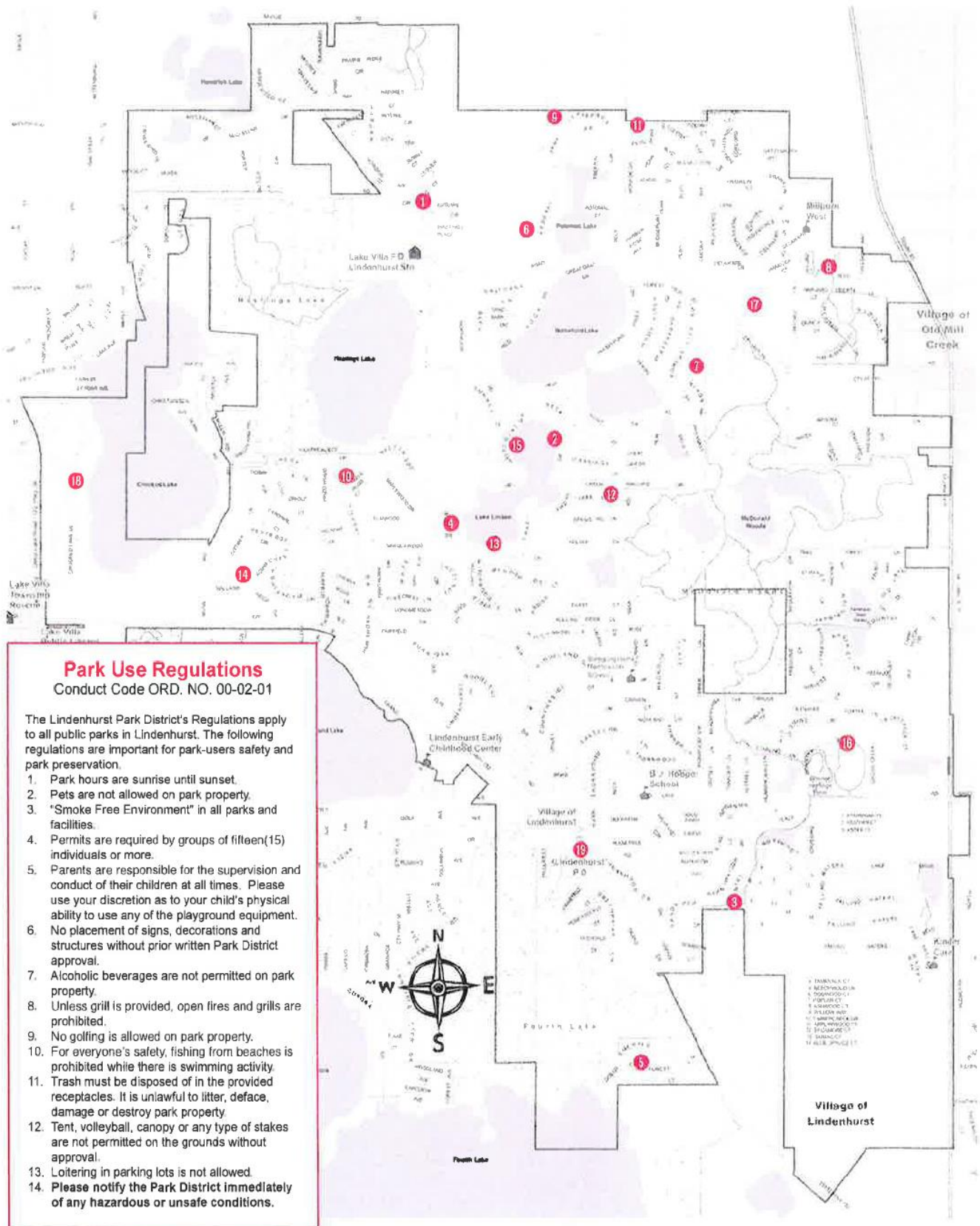
Parks
