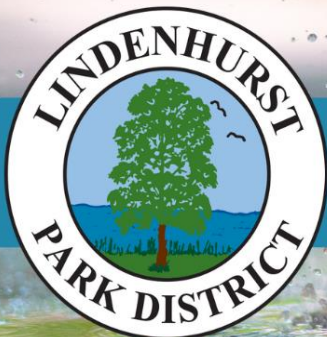

Primarily, the Park Board establishes policies based on sound research and consideration of community needs. They adopt policies that allow the Park District to run efficiently, effectively, legally, and ethically. They request, receive, evaluate, and make decisions based on guidance from the Executive Director. Lindenhurst Park District encourages public interaction and believes in being actively involved in our community.

About Us

Lindenhurst Park District is located in northwestern Lake County, Illinois. The District was formed on April 15, 1988. A five-member, non-paid elected board establishes district policy and provides direction on program and facility development. Our current park board has over 60 years of combined experience. We have a supporting cast of local individuals, organizations, government, and businesses, allowing our Park District to move forward progressively and accomplish improvements beneficial to you. Recreational opportunities continue growing with 19 named park sites, two beaches, 15 playgrounds, and 25 parcels of open space, totaling 134.5 acres, which offer great active features combined with designated passive/natural areas. We operate a 31,000 sq. ft. Community Center with a full-size gymnasium, 3-lane suspended walking/jogging track, aerobic and dance studios, senior/active adult room, preschool, multi-purpose and activity rooms, offices, and more, all ADA accessible. We have also made improvements at each named park and beach site within the decade, under a tax cap and without a referendum.

How to Create a New Client Account

If you do not have an account, go to our website at
www.lindenhurstparks.org.

1. Click on the **Registration Tab**.
2. Choose an activity to register for and click **"Create an account"** on the bottom left of the pop-up window. The account must belong to an adult 18 years or older.
3. You will receive an email confirmation that your account was successfully created. This email must be validated to activate your account information.
4. Lindenhurst residents must call before they register to receive the resident discount.

Log-in to an Existing Account

Once your account has been activated you can access it by going to www.lindenhurstparks.org selecting the **"My Account"** tab and clicking **"Log-in"** or choose the activity you want to register for and you will be prompted to log-in.

Your email address is your username. If you forget your password, reset with your username or choose to log in via Facebook, Google, or Office 365.

How Do I Pay?

Register online using Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover. For in-person or mail-in registration, cash, check, or charge payments may be made. Checks should be made payable to Lindenhurst Park District. There will be an automatic \$25.00 service charge on all returned checks and credit cards with insufficient funds.

Refund Policy

To receive a refund, you must withdraw from a program at least 7 days prior to the start. Program refunds will be less a \$5 service charge for programs under \$99 or a \$10 service charge for programs over \$100. Withdrawals within one week of the start date will only be refunded for medical reasons or relocation. Full refunds will be given when the district cancels programs due to low registration. Refunds will be processed within 14 days of request. Please note that all refunds will be processed as a household credit. Trips, one-time programs, and special event refunds will be less prepaid costs such as tickets, admission, and meals regardless of withdrawal date.

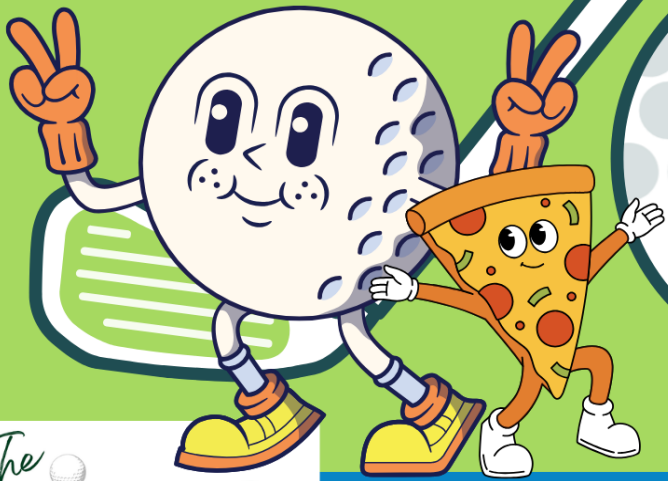

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

Registration Information

Families have the flexibility to register for the entire month (session), or by individual days (drop-in). Get the best value with monthly registration.

Monthly (Session) Registration

Monthly Registration allows you to register for all program days during the month; choose AM and/or PM care. You will be prompted to pay in full for that month or call to set up an installment plan breaking your monthly fee into two payments; the first payment is taken at the time of registration, and the second payment is on the 15 of the month. Pre-registration is required.

Daily (Drop-in) Registration

If you choose to register using the drop-in option, you have the flexibility to choose individual days throughout the month in both AM and/or PM care. Daily registration must be completed before the monthly deadline on a monthly basis unless you register and pay in full for the entire school year. Installment plans are not available for daily registration. Advanced registration is required.

Registration Deadlines

The registration deadline is 7 days prior to the beginning of the new month. Registration will be accepted after the deadline if space is available and will incur a \$40 automatic late fee.

Early Release/No School

The Before & After School Program will observe school holidays and institute days in accordance with Lake Villa District 41. Care is available for all Early Release days.

Transportation

Parents are responsible for contacting the school and bus service to arrange transportation. School Districts require students to have one drop-off and pick-up location throughout the year. If your child is not attending our program daily, consider using our location as their everyday pick-up/drop-off location.

Refund Policy

Refunds will not be given for any reason. You may stop registration at any time throughout the school year.

What to Bring

Bring a nut-free snack and water bottle each day.

FEES

- A non-refundable registration fee of \$50 per child is required at the time of registration.
- **AM Care:**
\$13 per day (daily) or \$12 per day (monthly).
- **PM Care:**
\$19 per day (daily) or \$18 per day (monthly).
- A Credit Card Authorization Form must be completed and on file AND/OR a credit card must be saved to your household account with the Park District to participate in the program.
- Installment billing can be set up by calling our office at 847.356.6011.

 - Add to your cart, and repeat as necessary for additional months, days, and times.
 - You will be prompted to pay in full for the individual days you selected (drop-in) or pay for the full month (session). Call our office if you need to set up installment billing.

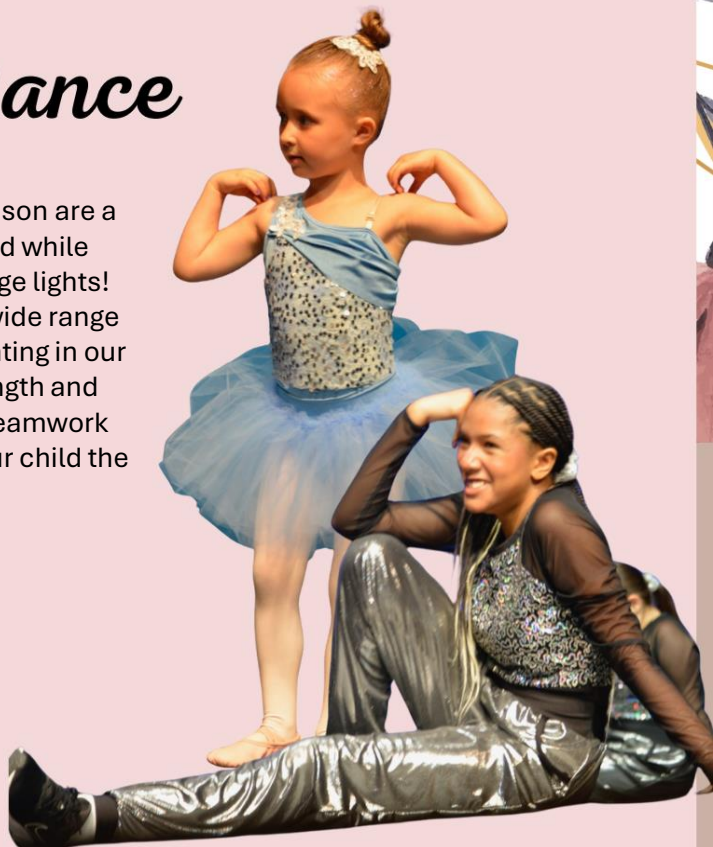

Studio Dance Center *Dance Class Descriptions*

Pitter Patter Feet

2.5-3 years

This is a creative dance and movement class for your little dancer. Through music, children will develop a sense of rhythm and creativity and develop their fine and gross motor skills while having fun! By the start of class, the child must be 2.5 years old and able to be independent from a guardian.

Attire: Leotard, tights, pink ballet shoes, pull-ups if not toilet trained.

3-4 years

Perfect for new dancers to explore popular dance styles! Basic fundamentals of classical ballet, including proper body alignment, agility, poise and grace, body awareness, and proper posture, are taught. Beginner tap techniques, using their toes and heels to make rhythmic sounds and beats on the floor, will put smiles on their faces when they make melodic sounds with their tap shoes.

Attire: Pink leotard, tights, pink ballet, tap, and jazz shoes. Hair in a bun or pulled back.

Princess Ballet

4-7 years

Outdoor Rentals

Picnic and Park

The Lindenhurst Park District is home to 19 parks developed to provide a variety of amenities including shelters and athletic fields available for seasonal rental. Fees help keep the shelters and fields clean and in working order at these picturesque parks.

Groups of 15 or more must secure a permit before their visit.

All shelters include picnic tables, shared restrooms, and ample parking. Grilling is permitted; however, grills are not provided. Renters may bring a portable electric or propane grill if it is 24 inches off the ground. Charcoal grills are prohibited.

Rentals begin on April 15 and end on October 15. Rent anytime from 10am-sunset.

Reservations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservation may be placed in person or via phone. A credit card number must be provided to keep on file for the \$100 security deposit. All rental fees must be paid two weeks prior to your rental. *Ask about our pricing for school districts, community groups, and commercial businesses.*

Linden's Landing Park Shelter

2100 Sprucewood Lane; located on the shores of Lake Linden.

Accommodates groups of up to 50

Features include: A shower tower, shared beach, sand volleyball and boat launch. Catch and release fishing is permitted.



Mallard Ridge Park Shelter

Throughout Lindenhurst, you will find tennis courts, basketball courts, pickleball courts, sand volleyball courts, full and youth-sized soccer fields, baseball and softball fields, and open turf. Open turf is versatile and perfect for all types of outdoor recreation.

The Lindenhurst Park District requires a Rental Permit or Special Use Permit for any gathering of 15 people or more at any Lindenhurst Park District park, shelter, field, or facility. Additionally, any organized groups and/or businesses may not conduct classes/camps/practices, rehearsals/training/meetings on Park District Property, regardless of group size, without a Rental or Special Use Permit.

Parkman Pavilion Rentals

Parkman Pavilion in Engle Memorial Park is a beautiful outdoor venue for ceremonies, parties or performances.

The pavilion is available to rent from April 15 - October 15 from 8:00am until sunset. The pavilion has a covered stage (approximately 20'x 30') with electricity available. There is lawn seating for approximately 100, with additional seating on the grass and six picnic tables.

Reservations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservation must be placed in person or via phone. A credit card number must be provided to keep on file for the \$100 security deposit. All rental fees must be paid 30 days prior to your rental. *Ask about pricing for school districts, community groups, and commercial businesses.* Rental approval may be required by the Board of Park Commissioners based on the event type.



Parks

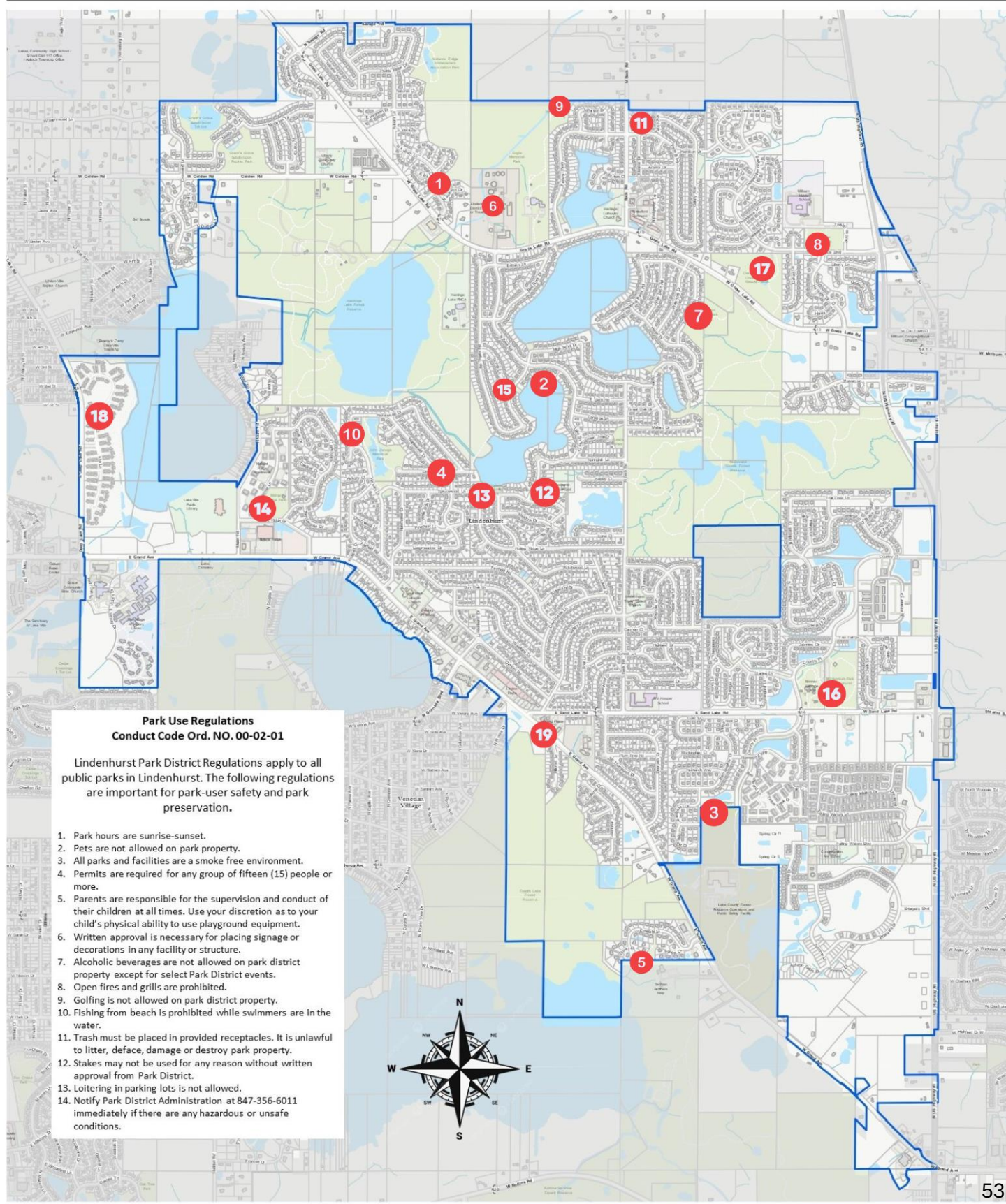
The Lindenhurst Park District currently manages 19 named park sites, including two beaches. These spaces offer users a variety of recreation options, including passive/natural areas and active areas.

Facilities

The Thomas J. Lippert Community Center is the central hub for programming in the Lindenhurst Park District. It is home to our registration and administrative offices, preschool classrooms, our Before and After School Program (Site 1), Dance/Fitness Studio, Active Adult space, and a gymnasium with a raised walking /running track and basic fitness equipment.

Lindenhurst Park District



Park Use Regulations Conduct Code Ord. NO. 00-02-01

Lindenhurst Park District Regulations apply to all public parks in Lindenhurst. The following regulations are important for park-user safety and park preservation.

1. Park hours are sunrise-sunset.
2. Pets are not allowed on park property.
3. All parks and facilities are a smoke free environment.
4. Permits are required for any group of fifteen (15) people or more.
5. Parents are responsible for the supervision and conduct of their children at all times. Use your discretion as to your child's physical ability to use playground equipment.
6. Written approval is necessary for placing signage or decorations in any facility or structure.
7. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on park district property except for select Park District events.
8. Open fires and grills are prohibited.
9. Golfing is not allowed on park district property.
10. Fishing from beach is prohibited while swimmers are in the water.
11. Trash must be placed in provided receptacles. It is unlawful to litter, deface, damage or destroy park property.
12. Stakes may not be used for any reason without written approval from Park District.
13. Loitering in parking lots is not allowed.
14. Notify Park District Administration at 847-356-6011 immediately if there are any hazardous or unsafe conditions.
