Lindenhurst Park District has a five (5) member Board. Board members are unpaid and elected to six (6) year-term positions. Park Board members must reside within the Park District boundaries. Primarily, the Park Board establishes policies based on sound research and consideration of community needs. They adopt policies that allow the Park District to run efficiently, effectively, legally, and ethically. They request, receive, evaluate, and make decisions based on guidance from the Executive Director. Lindenhurst Park District encourages public interaction and believes in being actively involved in our community.

Board Meetings

Regular meetings of the Park Board of Commissioners are held on the second Tuesday of each month at 6:00pm at the Lindenhurst Park District. The public is always invited to attend. About Us

Lindenhurst Park District is located in northwestern Lake County, Illinois. The District was formed on April 15, 1988. A five-member, non-paid elected board establishes district policy and provides direction on program and facility development. Our current park board has over 60 years of combined experience. We have a supporting cast of local individuals, organizations, government, and businesses, allowing our Park District to move forward progressively and accomplish improvements beneficial to you. Recreational opportunities continue growing with 19 named park sites, two beaches, 15 playgrounds, and 25 parcels of open space, totaling 134.5 acres, which offer great active features combined with designated passive/natural areas. We operate a 31,000 sq. ft. Community Center with a full-size gymnasium, 3-lane suspended walking/jogging track, aerobic and dance studios, senior/active adult room, preschool, multi-purpose and activity rooms, offices, and more, all ADA accessible. We have also made improvements at each named park and beach site within the decade, under a tax cap and without a referendum.

How Do I Pay?

Register online using Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover. For in-person or mail-in registration, cash, check, or charge payments may be made. Checks should be made payable to Lindenhurst Park District. There will be an automatic \$25.00 service charge on all returned checks and credit cards with insufficient funds.

Refund Policy

To receive a refund, you must withdraw from a program at least 7 days prior to the start. Program refunds will be less a \$5 service charge for programs under \$99 or a \$10 service charge for programs over \$100. Withdrawals within one week of the start date will only be refunded for medical reasons or relocation. Full refunds will be given when the district cancels programs due to low registration. Refunds will be processed within 14 days of request. Please note that all refunds will be processed as a household credit. Trips, one-time programs, and special event refunds will be less prepaid costs such as tickets, admission, and meals regardless of withdrawal date.

Are You R (resident) or NR (non-resident)?

Resident rates apply to people residing within the Lindenhurst Park District boundaries who contribute financial support to the Park District through property taxes. Non-residents live outside the Lindenhurst Park District boundaries and are always welcome. The easiest way to check your residency is to look at your county tax bill (check for Park District taxes paid). The Park District will ask for proof of residence to establish your discount.

Are you a **NEW** Lindenhurst Park District resident? Park District residents receive a 20% discount off most listed prices! Set up your resident discount by calling the office before registering online at 847.356.6011.

How to Create a New Client Account

If you do not have an account, go to our website at www.lindenhurstparks.org.

1. Click on the **Registration Tab**.
2. Choose an activity to register for and click **“Create an account”** on the bottom left of the pop-up window. The account must belong to an adult 18 years or older.
3. You will receive an email confirmation that your account was successfully created. This email must be validated to activate your account information.
4. Lindenhurst residents must call before they register to receive the resident discount.

Log-in to an Existing Account

Once your account has been activated you can access it by going to www.lindenhurstparks.org selecting the **“My Account”** tab and clicking **“Log-in”** or choose the activity you want to register for and you will be prompted to log-in.

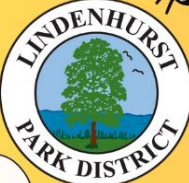

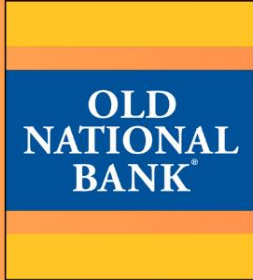

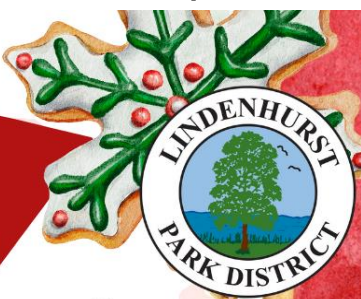

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

Registration Information

Families have the flexibility to register for the entire month or by individual days. Get the best value with monthly registration.

Monthly (Session) Registration

Monthly Registration allows you to register for all program days during the month; choose AM and/or PM care. You will be prompted to pay in full for that month or call to set up an installment plan breaking your monthly fee into two payments; the first payment is taken at the time of registration, and the second payment is on the 15 of the month. Advanced registration is required.

Daily (Drop-in) Registration

If you choose to register using the drop-in option, you have the flexibility to choose individual days throughout the month in both AM and/or PM care. Daily registration must be completed before the monthly deadline on a monthly basis unless you register and pay in full for the entire school year. Installment plans are not available for daily registration. Advanced registration is required.

Registration Deadlines

The registration deadline is the 25th of each month. Registration will be accepted after the deadline if space is available, but it will incur a \$40 automatic late fee.

Early Release/No School

The Before & After School Program will observe school holidays and institute days in accordance with Lake Villa District 41. Care is available for all Early Release dates.

Transportation

Parents are responsible for contacting the school and bus service to arrange transportation. School Districts require students to have one drop-off and pick-up location throughout the year. If your child is not attending our program daily, consider using our location as their everyday pick-up/drop-off location.

Refund Policy

Refunds will not be given for any reason. You may stop registration at any time throughout the school year.

What to Bring

Bring a nut-free snack and water bottle each day.

FEES

- A non-refundable registration fee of \$50 per household is required at the time of registration.
- **AM Care:**
\$12 per day (daily) or \$11 per day (monthly)
- **PM Care:**
\$18 per day (daily) or \$16 per day (monthly)
- A Credit Card Authorization Form must be completed and on file AND/OR a credit card must be saved to your household account with the Park District to participate in the program.
- Installment billing can be set up by calling our office at 847.356.6011.

 - Add to your cart, and repeat as necessary for additional months, days, and times.
 - You will be prompted to pay in full for the individual days you selected (drop-in) or pay for the full month (session). Call our office if you need to set up installment billing.

Class Descriptions

Young 3-Year-Old Early Learner Program

To register for preschool, visit www.lindenhurstparks.org and follow these tabs.

- *Registration>Engle Junction Preschool*
- Scroll to the bottom of the page and click *Registration & Program Information>Registration*
- Select "*Engle Junction Preschool 25-26*" at the bottom of the page
- Choose the appropriate age and class selection
- You will be prompted to pay in full or select monthly installments for the school year

A \$50 non-refundable registration fee will be charged at the time of enrollment.

If you choose monthly installments, a one-month deposit (used for the last month) will be charged at the time of registration. Then, eight equal payments will automatically be charged to a credit or debit card on the first day of each month beginning in September (the last payment will be withdrawn on April 1). A \$40 late fee applies if a payment is returned for insufficient funds.

Early Learner Program: If you register for session 1 and session 2 at the same time, you may call our office to postpone your session 2 deposit until December 1, 2025.

Monthly installments are based on the total tuition cost divided into nine equal payments (not the number of days per month).

Requirements

- All children must be able to use the restroom independently unless enrolled in the Young 3-year-old Early Learner program.
- When enrolling in Engle Junction Preschool, your child must be the appropriate age by September 1.



Refund Policy

Refunds will not be given for a partial month's attendance or withdrawal. The last month's tuition payment, (paid at the time of registration), is non-refundable after August 15. If a refund request is made before August 15, a refund will be processed, less a \$10 service charge. If you would like to withdraw, contact our front office at 847.356.6011.

Pitter Patter Feet

2.5-3 years

This is a creative dance and movement class for your little dancer. Children will develop a sense of rhythm and creativity through music and movement. The Lindenhurst Park District is home to 19 parks developed to provide a variety of amenities including shelters and athletic fields available for seasonal rental. Fees help keep the shelters and fields clean and in working order at these picturesque parks.

All groups of 15 or more must obtain a Rental or Special Use Permit prior to their visit. Special Use Permits require approval from the Board of Park Commissioners.

All shelters include picnic tables, shared restrooms, and ample parking. Grilling is permitted; however, grills are not provided. Renters may bring a portable electric or propane grill if it is 24 inches off the ground. Charcoal grills are prohibited.

Rentals begin on April 15 and end on October 15. Rent anytime from 10am-sunset.

Reservations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis and may be made in person or by phone. A valid credit card must be provided to keep on file for the required \$100 deposit. All rental fees must be paid in full at least two weeks prior to the reservation date. Ask about our pricing for school districts, community groups, and commercial businesses.

Parks

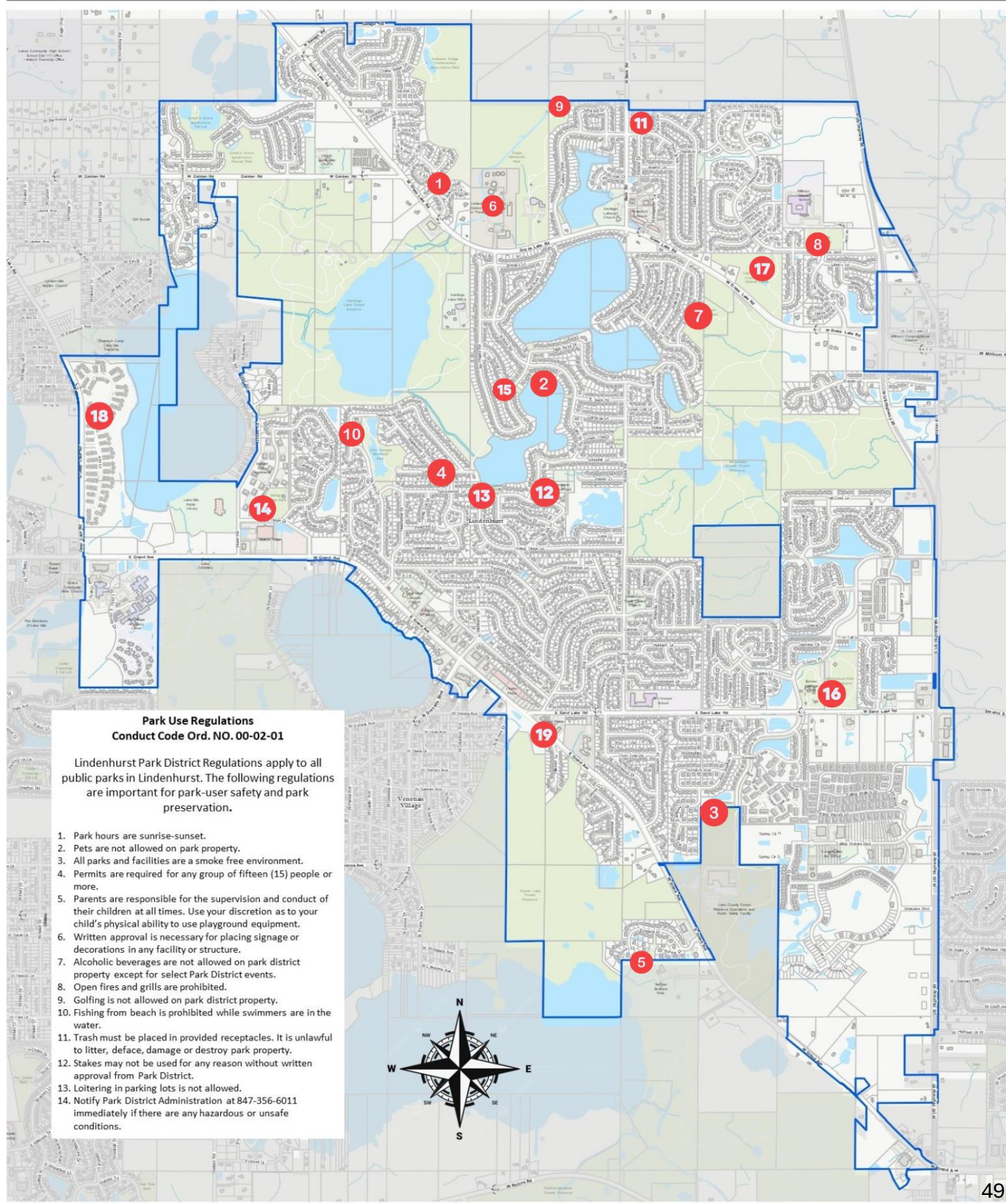
The Lindenhurst Park District currently manages 19 named park sites, including two beaches. These spaces offer users a variety of recreational options, including passive/natural areas, as well as active areas.

Facilities

The Thomas J. Lippert Community Center is the central hub for programming in the Lindenhurst Park District. It is home to our registration and administrative offices, preschool classrooms, our Before and After School Program (Site 1), Dance/Fitness Studio, Active Adult space, and a gymnasium with a raised walking /running track and basic fitness equipment.

Park District's Open Space Standards is to maintain or exceed a land acreage-to-resident ratio of 1 acre to every 1,000 residents (N.R.P.A. Park Use Regulations Conduct Code Ord. NO. 00-02-01

Lindenhurst Park District Regulations apply to all public parks in Lindenhurst. The following regulations are important for park-user safety and park preservation.

1. Park hours are sunrise-sunset.
2. Pets are not allowed on park property.
3. All parks and facilities are a smoke free environment.
4. Permits are required for any group of fifteen (15) people or more.
5. Parents are responsible for the supervision and conduct of their children at all times. Use your discretion as to your child's physical ability to use playground equipment.
6. Written approval is necessary for placing signage or decorations in any facility or structure.
7. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on park district property except for select Park District events.
8. Open fires and grills are prohibited.
9. Golfing is not allowed on park district property.
10. Fishing from beach is prohibited while swimmers are in the water.
11. Trash must be placed in provided receptacles. It is unlawful to litter, deface, damage or destroy park property.
12. Stakes may not be used for any reason without written approval from Park District.
13. Loitering in parking lots is not allowed.
14. Notify Park District Administration at 847-356-6011 immediately if there are any hazardous or unsafe conditions.
