Primarily, the Park Board establishes policies based on sound research and consideration of community needs. They adopt policies that allow the Park District to run efficiently, effectively, legally, and ethically. They request, receive, evaluate, and make decisions based on guidance from the Executive Director. Lindenhurst Park District encourages public interaction and believes in being actively involved in our community.

About Us

Lindenhurst Park District is located in northwestern Lake County, Illinois. The District was formed on April 15, 1988.

A five-member, non-paid elected board establishes district policy and provides direction on program and facility development. Our current park board has over 60 years of combined experience.

We have a supporting cast of local individuals, organizations, government, and businesses, allowing our Park District to move forward progressively and accomplish improvements beneficial to you. Recreational opportunities continue growing with 19 named park sites, two beaches, 15 playgrounds, and 25 parcels of open space, totaling 134.5 acres, which offer great active features combined with designated passive/natural areas.

We operate a 31,000 sq. ft. Community Center with a full-size gymnasium, 3-lane suspended walking/jogging track, aerobic and dance studios, senior/active adult room, preschool, multi-purpose and activity rooms, offices, and more, all ADA accessible. We have also made improvements at each named park and beach site within the decade, under a tax cap and without a referendum.

How Do I Pay?

Register online using Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover. For in-person or mail-in registration, cash, check, or charge payments may be made. Checks should be made payable to Lindenhurst Park District. There will be an automatic \$25.00 service charge on all returned checks and credit cards with insufficient funds.

Refund Policy

To receive a refund, you must withdraw from a program at least 7 days prior to the start. Program refunds will be less a \$5 service charge for programs under \$99 or a \$10 service charge for programs over \$100. Withdrawals within one week of the start date will only be refunded for medical reasons or relocation. Full refunds will be given when the district cancels programs due to low registration. Refunds will be processed within 14 days of request. Please note that all refunds will be processed as a household credit. Trips, one-time programs, and special event refunds will be less prepaid costs such as tickets, admission, and meals regardless of withdrawal date.

Are You R (resident) or NR (non-resident)?

Resident rates apply to people residing within the Lindenhurst Park District boundaries who contribute financial support to the Park District through property taxes. Non-residents live outside the Lindenhurst Park District boundaries and are always welcome. The easiest way to check your residency is to look at your county tax bill (check for Park District taxes paid). The Park District will ask for proof of residence to establish your discount.

How to Create a New Client Account

If you do not have an account, go to our website at www.lindenhurstparks.org.

- 1. Click on the Registration Tab.
- Choose an activity to register for and click "Create an account" on the bottom left of the pop-up window. The account must belong to an adult 18 years or older.
- You will receive an email confirmation that your account was successfully created. This email must be validated to activate your account information.
- Lindenhurst residents must call before they register to receive the resident discount.



TWO SITES AVAILABLE

Our program operates at two sites to serve all students in K-5 at District 41 and Oakland Elementary (District 34).

SITE ONE:

Lindenhurst Park District Lippert Community Center- Activity 1 2200 E. Grass Lake Road, Lindenhurst

Site One is for students in grades K-5 enrolled at Oakland Elementary (D34) and BJ Hooper (D41). Children will have access to a full-sized gym, track, playgrounds, parks, walking paths, and classroom space for activities.

SITE TWO:

Lake Villa Township

Caboose Park- Community Room A (Lower part of building)

Site Two is for students in grades K-5 enrolled at Martin School (D41) and Thompson School (D41). Children will have access to open green spaces, playgrounds, sports fields, and classroom space for activities.

Registration Information

Families have the flexibility to register for the entire month or by individual days. Get the best value with monthly registration.

Monthly (Session) Registration

Monthly Registration allows you to register for all program days during the month; choose AM and/or PM care. You will be prompted to pay in full for that month or call to set up an installment plan, breaking your monthly fee into two payments; the first payment is taken at the time of registration, and the second payment is on the 15th of the month. Advanced registration is required.

Daily (Drop-in) Registration

If you choose to register using the drop-in option, you have the flexibility to choose individual days throughout the month in both AM and/or PM care. Daily registration must be completed before the monthly deadline on a monthly basis, unless you register and pay in full for the entire school year. Installment plans are not available for daily registration. Advanced registration is required.

Registration Deadlines

The registration deadline is the 25th of each month. Registration will be accepted after the deadline if space is available and will incur a \$40 automatic late fee.

Early Release/No School

The Before & After School Program will observe school holidays and institute days in accordance with Lake Villa District 41. Care is available for all Early Release days.

Transportation

Parents are responsible for contacting the school and bus service to arrange transportation. School Districts require students to have one drop-off and pick-up location throughout the year. If your child is not attending our program daily, consider using our location as their everyday pick-up/drop-off location.

Refund Policy

Refunds will not be given for any reason. You may stop registration at any time throughout the school year.

What to Bring

Bring a nut-free snack and water bottle each day.

FEES

- A non-refundable registration fee of \$50 per household is required at the time of registration.
- AM Care:
 - \$12 per day (daily) or \$11 per day (monthly)
- PM Care:
 - \$18 per day (daily) or \$16 per day (monthly)
- A Credit Card Authorization Form must be completed and on file AND/OR a credit card must be saved to your household account with the Park District to participate in the program
- Installment billing can be set up by calling our office at 847.356.6011.

Registration is completed online. Registration for the 2026-2027 school year will begin at 9:00am on the following dates:

- You will be prompted to pay in full or select monthly installments for the school year.

A \$50 non-refundable registration fee will be charged at the time of enrollment.

If you choose monthly installments, a one-month deposit (used for the last month) will be charged at the time of registration. Then, eight equal payments will automatically be charged to a credit or debit card on the first day of each month beginning in September (the last payment will be withdrawn on April 1). A \$40 late fee applies if a payment is returned for insufficient funds.

Monthly installments are based on the total tuition cost divided into nine equal payments (not the number of days per month).

Requirements

- •All children must be able to use the restroom independently.
- •When enrolling in Engle Junction Preschool, your child must be the appropriate age by September 1.

Class Cancellations

All preschool classes must meet a minimum enrollment by July 15. If a class does not meet this requirement, it will be cancelled. Families affected will be given the option to:

- Be registered in another age-appropriate class if space is available
- Be placed on a waitlist

Refund Policy

Refunds will not be given for a partial month's attendance or withdrawal. The last month's tuition payment, (paid at the time of registration), is non-refundable after July 15. If a refund request is made before July 15, a refund will be processed, less a \$10 service charge. If you would like to withdraw, contact our front office at 847.356.6011.

Picnic and Park

The Lindenhurst Park District is home to 19 parks developed to provide a variety of amenities including shelters and athletic fields available for seasonal rental. Fees help keep the shelters and fields clean and in working order at these picturesque parks.

All groups of 15 or more must obtain a Rental or Special Use Permit prior to their visit. Special Use Permits require approval from the Board of Park Commissioners.

All shelters include picnic tables, shared restrooms, and ample parking. Grilling is permitted; however, grills are not provided. Renters may bring a portable electric or propane grill if it is 24 inches off the ground. Charcoal grills are prohibited

Rentals begin on April 15 and end on October 15. Rent anytime from 10am-sunset.

Reservations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis and may be made in person or by phone. A valid credit card must be provided to keep on file for the required \$100 deposit. All rental fees must be paid in full at least two weeks prior to the reservation date. Ask about our pricing for school districts, community groups, and commercial businesses.

Court, Field and Turf Rentals

Throughout Lindenhurst, you will find tennis courts, basketball courts, pickleball courts, sand volleyball courts, full and youth-sized soccer fields, baseball and softball fields, and open turf. Open turf is versatile and perfect for all types of outdoor recreation.

A Special Use Permit is required for any event held in Lindenhurst Park District parks beyond standard public use of a rental. Designed for any group size of 15 or more who wish to gather in the park but do not want to rent a shelter. Types of events include charity, running/walking, cross-country runs, filming, for-profit, school groups, church services, etc. Use of District property for day camps, instructional classes, or organized groups not sponsored by the Park District. Anticipated attendance of more than 200 or certain specified activities will require Director and Board approval.



Facilities
