



Lindenhurst Studio Dance 2026 Recital Parent Guide “Everybody Dance”

Dear Lindenhurst Studio Dance Families,

Recital time is fast approaching, and students have been learning so much and are so eager to perform! Below are important dates and information you will need to know and adhere to for a smooth rehearsal, recital and pictures for your dancer. Remember to get your child to each class before the recital date to ensure that your dancer is ready and up to date on any choreography changes.

Recital Information

The 2026 recital, *“Everybody Dance”* will take place:

- Doors will open to the public at 12:30 p.m.
- Dancers and chaperones must arrive **no later than 12:20 pm**. Dancers should be dropped off with their designated class chaperone at the auditorium entrance hallway and signed in by a parent or guardian. Chaperones will be waiting with their class group in the hallway with a name tag.
- Dancers will not be released until the show is over and will stay backstage until after the end of the finale. The show will last about 1 hour and 30 minutes.
- No flash photography or videotaping is allowed during performances. Still photography without flash is permitted.
- Only water and dry snacks are allowed backstage.

- Picture Order forms will be handed out during class closer to the recital date.
- Dancers should arrive in full costume 15 minutes prior to their picture time. Each dance class will take a group and individual pictures during their designated time slot below. Following pictures, classes will proceed backstage with their chaperone line up and rehearse their routines. Dancers are free to leave after being dismissed by their teacher.
- **Please have your dancer ready and in full costume, including shoes, make-up, and hair. Treat this rehearsal just like the actual recital.**

Chaperones – We Need You!

Volunteer chaperones are needed to assist backstage before and during the show. If you are interested in volunteering contact Ms. Angelique at lppardancedirector@gmail.com Chaperones will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. Chaperones will be required to chaperone **both** the rehearsal and recital.

Duties include keeping your group entertained during off-stage time, lining up for performances, and managing costume changes if necessary. Activities will be provided in dressing rooms to stay busy until performance time.

Parents volunteering to Chaperone will not need to purchase a ticket to the show and will have exclusive backstage access to see their child perform from the wings of the stage. Please note: Siblings and other family members will not be allowed in the dressing rooms or backstage.

Chaperones will check in at a separate table near the backstage entrance – no ticket is required at the door.

Costumes, Shoes, Tights, Hair & Make-up

- Dancers are asked to refrain from wearing underwear. The tights have a built-in crotch for comfort and a seamless show with the costume.
- **Tights** are required and can be purchased at Amazon, Target, Walmart, or any dance supply store. Parents are responsible for purchasing tights. Tights should not have any lines across the thighs.
- **Make-up** is up to the parent's discretion; glitter and lip gloss are plenty for very young dancers.
- All belongings should be labeled and kept in a bag (labeled) in the dressing room. Tip: Use a silver sharpie or nail polish on the bottom of tap shoes and mark the inside of ballet shoes with a permanent marker with child's initials. Chaperones will not be responsible for any lost or unmarked items. Please label **ALL** your belongings.
- Ballet shoestrings must be trimmed to 2 inches or shorter; tuck the strings inside toe of shoe so they do not come undone during the performance.

Dance 1	Nude tights, pink ballet shoes & black tap shoes, hair half up
Dance 2	Nude tights, pink ballet shoes & black tap shoes, hair half up
Dance 3 Combo	Nude tights, pink ballet shoes, nude jazz shoes, black tap shoes, hair in low ponytail
Princess Ballet	White tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in bun
Jr Hip-Hop (all classes)	Black sneakers, girl's hair in high ponytail
Beginner Jazz	Nude jazz shoes, hair in low ponytail
Beginner Lyrical Dance	Nude footies and hair in low pony
Advance Lyrical Dance	Nude footies, full nude body suit

Purchasing Tickets

- Tickets go on sale Monday, May 18, 2026, at 9:00am and will be available to purchase online.
- Tickets are \$15 per person for ages 3 years and up. There is no limit on ticket purchases – bring the whole family!
- Children under the age of 3 may sit on an adult's lap at no charge, or a separate seat may be purchased for them.
- Physical tickets will not be issued. The name entered at checkout will be placed on a check-n list along with the number of tickets purchased. Upon arrival, please provide the ticket usher with the name used for the purchase, the number of tickets purchased, and the total number of people in your party.
- All tickets must be purchased by Friday, May 29, 2026.

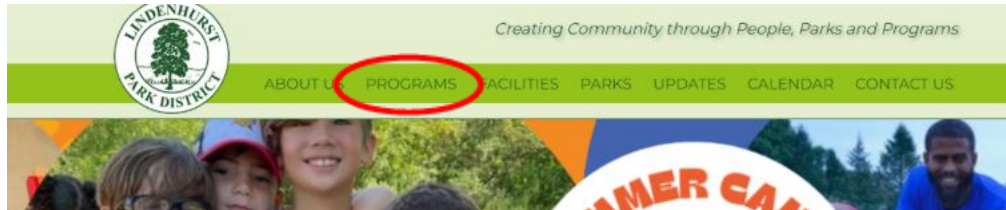
Ticket Purchasing Guide
